

The Clear Lake City Council met in special session on Friday, May 1, 2020, at 5:30 PM. in the Conference Room of the Municipal Building with Mayor Gary Eide presiding. Those present were Alderwoman Kelli Bauman, Aldermen Carey Holt, Harry Mewherter, John Keimig, Jon Klockman and Dean Christensen. Motion by Holt, seconded by Keimig to approve the agenda. All voted aye. Motion carried.

The second reading of Ordinance No. 585, an Ordinance Regarding COVID-19, was completed. Motion by Mewherter, seconded by Keimig to approve Ordinance No. 585. Upon roll-call vote the following votes were cast: Bauman-yes; Christensen-yes; Holt-no; Klockman-yes; Keimig-yes; Mewherter-yes. Motion carried.

Resolution 2020-7, a Resolution about reopening businesses and organizations at half capacity, was read. After some discussion about surrounding cities reopening there was a motion by Keimig, seconded by Klockman, to approve Resolution 2020-7. Upon roll-call vote the following votes were cast: Bauman-yes; Christensen-yes; Holt-yes; Klockman-yes; Keimig-yes; Mewherter-yes. Motion carried.

There being no further business, motion by Keimig, seconded by Klockman to adjourn at 5:55 PM. All voted aye. Motion carried.
