

The Clear Lake City Council met in special session on Wednesday, April 13, 2022 at 5:30pm in the Conference Room of the Municipal Building with Mayor Gary Eide presiding. Those present were Alderwomen Kelli Bauman, Rose Mack, and Lisa Lundberg; Aldermen Carey Holt, Harry Mewherter, and John Keimig. Also present was Mary Korth and Attorney Todd Boyd. The Pledge of Allegiance was said.

Motion by Bauman, seconded by Mack to approve the agenda. Upon roll call, all voted aye. Motion carried.

No one appeared for public voice.

The official canvass of votes from the 2022 Mayoral Election and Ward II election held on April 12th was completed. Official results of the election are:

FOR MAYOR:

192 votes for Lisa Lundberg

80 votes for Andrew Braam

FOR ALDERMAN WARD II:

72 votes for Jonas Reppe

16 votes for John T Keimig

With no contest of the election, results were approved by the Board of Canvassers. Motion by Keimig, seconded by Holt to approve the canvass of votes by the Board of Canvassers. Upon roll call vote, all voted yes and motion carried.

In other business, Todd Boyd presented three (3) plats to the Council as described: 1. "Industrial Park Addition, An Addition To The City Of Clear Lake, Deuel County, South Dakota" located in NE1/4 of 15-115-49; 2. "Lots 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8 and 9; And Road ROWs; All In Industrial Park Addition, An Addition To The City Of Clear Lake, Deuel County, South Dakota"; 3. "Northside Acres to the City of Clear Lake, Deuel County, South Dakota" located in NE1/4 of 15-*115-49.

Motion by Mewherter, seconded by Lundberg to accept the plats presented as described. Upon roll call vote, all voted yes with Holt abstaining. Motion carried.

Motion by Keimig, seconded by Mack to approve Mayor Gary Eide to sign the owners certificate for each plat presented and listed above as described for transfer of ownership. Upon roll call vote, all voted yes with Holt abstaining. Motion carried.

There being no further business, motion by Mewherter, seconded by Holt to adjourn at 5:55 PM. All voted aye. Motion carried.
